Discuss processes and frameworks to plan experiments ahead, and therefore make the most out of time, money, data and your effort overall!

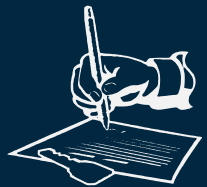


Mental Health
